### Frequently Asked Questions about our Capital Campaign and New Parish Home

This week a campaign packet was mailed to every registered parish family containing a beautiful brochure, a Questions & Answers pamphlet and cover letter from Fr. James. If you have not received one in the mail by this week please call the parish office and we will send another to your home.

**Q: Why do we need a fancy brochure?**

**A:** The brochure may appear “fancy and expensive” but it is borne out of stewardship from parishioners who freely donated their talents. By using their talents we were able to design the brochure without cost – a savings of many thousands of dollars. Likewise, the bulk of the printing expense was donated.

The design and layout of the brochure was created by John Riviera of Rivi Graphics, writing and texts were composed by Renee Crowe, and the photography was created by Misty Trefry and John Riviera. This brochure and other campaign literature will be accessible for preview on the parish’s website thanks to the stewardship work by Guy Mendt. We extend our thanks to them and all the campaign volunteers for a great deal of work and dedication.

The rationale for a brochure is to produce something we can review at our own convenience. The inclusion of information about the project is meant for us to prayerfully reflect upon. The giving chart allows us to realize that we can make a substantial gift by giving small amounts over the course of four (4) years. The drawings give us hope and incentive for truly beautiful and Christ centered buildings. This is the only tangible evidence of our campaign until the church is built and every parishioner should have this information.
