## Frequently Asked Questions about our New Parish Home

**Q: What will we do with the current '*For Our Parish Building Fund*' envelopes?**

A: We will be phasing out the use of these envelopes over the next 2 months as people begin to make pledges for the campaign. When making a pledge, you have the option to fund it by remitting a check, having it automatically deducted from a checking or savings account, or having it automatically put on a credit card. When selecting the last two options you may elect to have the transaction performed on the 5<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. Your options include payment submitted monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, or annually.

If you elect to fund your pledge by checks, the office will send you a reminder based on your selected frequency of payment (monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually). You can make these payments by dropping them in the collection basket or mailing them to the parish office. Any payments made after April 1, 2008 using the '*For Our Parish Building Fund*' envelopes will automatically be credited to a building pledge if you make one.

**For example:** If you make a \$50 contribution this weekend using the '*For Our Parish Building Fund*' envelopes and you make a campaign pledge several weeks from now, then the \$50 contribution from this weekend will be automatically applied to the payment of your pledge.

It is our hope that all families make a pledge rather than give through the loose check method. Making a pledge assures we can accurately plan on building income. We hope that everyone will prayerfully consider making a pledge and welcome a campaign volunteer as a brother or sister in Christ.
